WHAT MADE YOU PLAN A DESTINATION WEDDING IN HAWAI'!?

WHAT WAS YOUR FAVOURITE PART ABOUT THE WEDDING DAY?

There are some venues that are portrayed well online, but may not be ideal for your specific taste and requirements."

WHAT MADE YOU PLAN A DESTINATION WEDDING IN GREECE?

"We opted for a destination wedding for our special day because we felt it would allow us to have more quality time to spend with friends and family in a new locale. We were delighted that they travelled from all over to join us on our special day.

Specifically, Mykonos was the perfect destination for two reasons. First, it formed the perfect middle ground for both our families travelling from the States and Europe.
